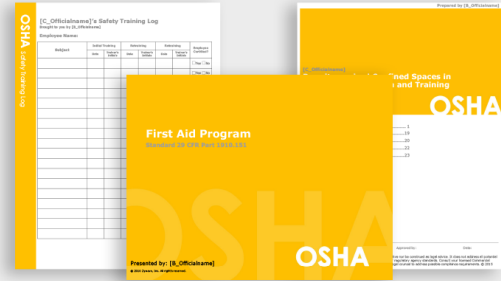

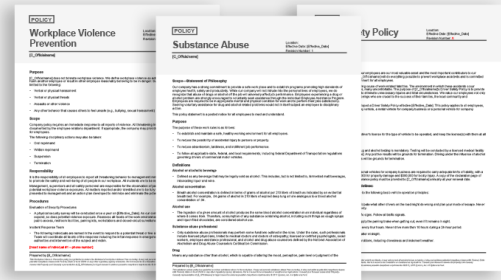
EMPLOYEE SAFETY MANUALS
